Holy expectancy in worship - Acts 4:23-31, 2 Chronicles 5:1-14

1. How much of an appetite do you think we have in church to share Jesus more boldly and see signs and wonders like the apostles in Acts 4?
2. Have you ever felt under pressure to silence your voice about Jesus? Tell the group a bit about it.
3. What does God's sovereignty mean for you?
4. What do you think it might mean to have 'timid convictions' about God?
5. What do we expect to happen as we gather to worship Sunday by Sunday?
6. Have you ever had a time during worship where you have experienced the Presence or Power of God? Describe the experience to the group.
7. If we really believe that Jesus is alive and present among his people, what practical difference would that make to our approach to worship?
8. How do you personally tend to prepare for worship?
9. What do you think people come to worship expectant for?
10. What might it mean for God to be enthroned on our praises (Psalm 22)?
